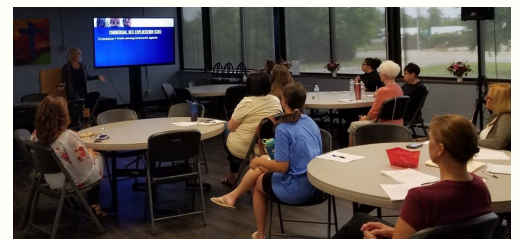


Our safe houses are operating at almost maximum capacity and the residents are making great strides in healing. Praise God!
