I came to Oasis after graduating from drug and alcohol treatment and began to build relationships with the Oasis ladies. I was used, and my body was sold against my will in my past. Due to building relationships with the Oasis ladies, I ran to them knowing they would provide a safe home for me.

They have provided a safe environment/home for me. I am assisted with everything I need to have a clean home. They provide brooms, mops, cleaning supplies and a security system for the house. I am provided with all the personal hygiene I could ever ask for. I even have a TV and a laptop in the common area. I am provided a weekly therapist which has helped me. I still feel I have many issues I need to work through, but it's a new beginning.

Oasis assisted with helping me obtain competitive employment located in the same building with a company that is willing to work with someone trying to put her feet back into the work environment. They have provided financial assistance when needed and work with my medical issues. I know I am safe with Oasis and I know my life would not be where it is if I didn't have Oasis daily support.
