**A:** I'd been looking for a way to get involved in fighting against sex trafficking. I'd been aware of the issue of prostitution from a young age because of where I grew up.

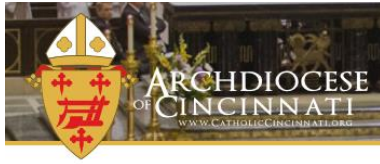
**Q:** What's the best thing to happen since you started working with Oasis House?
